What CLAIM is

CLAIM is a startup. We built the AI that turns what happened to a person on OnlyFans or Fansly into evidence banks accept. No lawyers, no forms, minutes not months. Someone paid a "creator" who wasn't who they said; the AI names the pattern, writes the first letter to the platform, builds the bank package, reads the replies and says what to do next. The client sends everything themselves, in their own name. A real person is beside them the whole way.

Not a legal service. The bank decides the outcome. CLAIM's one promise is about its own price, and it sounds the same everywhere: *If nothing comes back in two weeks, the money comes back to you.*

Your money. Your calm way back.

Site claim-project.com	A one-minute film, a free check, the first letter free, the price, the patterns.	The one link that explains everything without you. Send it when they ask.
Claim Care @claim_care_bot	The AI for the case, in Telegram. Buttons only.	Your partner link leads here. Payment → eight answers → documents → bank. The bot takes the person to the end.
The film in @claim_project	The founder's voice, one minute, the whole product.	Forward it from the channel. It does the explaining and names the price for you.
A person @claim_project_support	The human side of Claim Care.	Every client question you'd rather not answer — here. In writing, the same day.
Founder @kris_claim	Kris, directly.	Ideas, partnership, money. One message, an answer the same day.

Every number has a screenshot behind it. CLAIM takes nothing from what comes back to a person — that's yours to say out loud.

Who we help — so you recognise them in a minute

A person paid a "creator" on OnlyFans or Fansly by card — subscriptions, tips, custom content, "help me out" — and the account was run by someone else: an agency, a chatter, a team. Not disclosed. Sometimes hundreds of dollars, sometimes thousands. Most never say it out loud. Many have already been told "that's on you" by a friend or a bank.

DOESN'T KNOW YET

Feels something is off — replies too fast, too many "emergencies", the same words every night. Needs one fact: what this pattern is called, and that a bank reads it.

SUSPECTS

Has screenshots, has doubts, has already googled "OnlyFans scam refund". Needs a door that isn't a lawyer and isn't a form.

KNOWS

Angry or ashamed, sometimes both. Tried the bank once, got a "no". Needs the second letter — the one that names the pattern and dates every payment.

Where they are: English-speaking, any age, any country with a card. They write in public when it's fresh, and tell a friend when it's old. They don't answer ads. They answer a person who says one true sentence.

Any traffic works — social, communities, your own audience, people you know. How you reach them is yours; the only two lines are in section 08.

The partnership in three lines

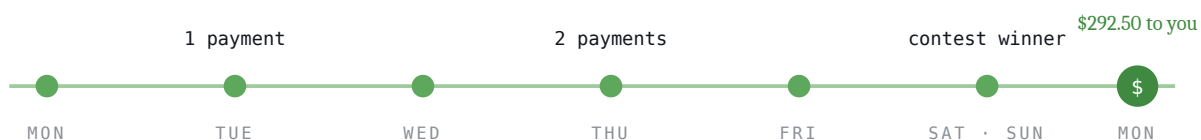

ONE WEEK, THREE PAYMENTS — PAID NEXT MONDAY

Your link — two minutes

Open @claim_care_bot → **Refer a friend** → three lines → "I agree". The bot gives you the link t.me/claim_care_bot?start=ref_CODE, this guide, and your cabinet: clicks · payments · payout due · next payout. Always one tap away.

What the person sees through your link

The bot's first message tells them openly: "a partner invited you — they receive half of what you pay." That's not small print. That's the method: a person told the truth before the money trusts you after it.

The money — three rhythms

PAYMENTS A MONTH	YOURS	WHAT IT LOOKS LIKE
1	\$97.50	One person you told, once and honestly, how this works.
10	\$975	A few replies a day where people already write about it, and the people who ask you.
20	\$1,950	Your own rhythm: several places, your channel, the weekly contest as your lead magnet.
50	\$4,875	A system: your audience, your posts, your replies — and the film doing the selling.

A payment counts when access opens (Stars — at once; USDT and other ways — after a person confirms, within the day). You see every payment in your cabinet the same day. No ceiling. No quota.

You don't sell. You show what already works — and say you get half.

Where people are — the map

Every day people write, in public and to friends: "paid on OnlyFans, turned out it wasn't her, what do I do". They are looking for exactly this. Any of these places works; none is required.

PEOPLE YOU KNOW

Whoever told you such a story. The film forwarded and one word: "Want me to show you?"

YOUR OWN AUDIENCE

A channel, a page, a newsletter, a stream. Say openly that you're a partner and get half — it reads as strength, not sales.

COMMUNITIES

Reddit, Telegram groups, Discord servers, forums — wherever people compare notes on creators, chargebacks, dating. Reply under real posts as a person; the link when asked.

X · THREADS · TIKTOK COMMENTS

Search the words people use ("OnlyFans scam", "chargeback OnlyFans", "fake creator"). Reply with one fact. Repost @claim_community with your line.

THE WEEKLY CONTEST

One full access free, every week. "Write your story — Sunday one of you gets access for free." Real stories come, and people who then pay.

CREATORS' SIDE

Creators whose name was used by someone else have fans who lost money. That's a conversation, not an ad.

Any place not on this page is yours to try. Tell Kris what worked — it goes into the next version of this guide with your name on it, if you want.

What to say — three sentences

Fact first. "The money you sent to someone who wasn't who they said — a bank can send it back." **The product.** "A startup called CLAIM built the AI that turns your screenshots into the documents the bank accepts, in minutes." **One question, one word.** "Want me to show you?"

Then the film, forwarded from @claim_project — it names the price in the founder's voice, so you never have to. Then the link, when they say yes. That's the whole script.

Three replies — wherever someone writes it

WHEN SOMEONE WRITES "I GOT SCAMMED, THE MONEY'S GONE"

The card payments can be disputed with your bank as "not as described" — it's a normal chargeback, not a scam report. A startup called CLAIM builds the whole bank package from your screenshots in minutes; I've seen it work. Happy to say more if you want.

WHEN SOMEONE WRITES "THE BANK REFUSED / THE PLATFORM ISN'T ANSWERING"

A first refusal isn't the end — the bank answers the letter it received, and most first letters say the wrong thing. The second one has to name the pattern and date every payment. There's an AI (CLAIM) that does exactly that from what you already have. If you want, I'll send the link.

WHEN SOMEONE ASKS "IS THIS LEGIT?"

Fair question. It's not a legal service and nobody promises an outcome — the bank decides. What it does is turn what happened to you into documents the bank accepts. Their one rule: if nothing comes back in two weeks, the money comes back to you. I get half of what people pay through my link — that's also why I only send it when asked.

Two things we keep — and everything else is open

THE LAW

People who came to you or wrote in public. No lists, no databases, no exports — yours or anyone's. Nothing promised that the bank decides; the guarantee only as it's written. Nobody named — no creators, no agencies, no clients. "Not a legal service" is the one place the word legal appears.

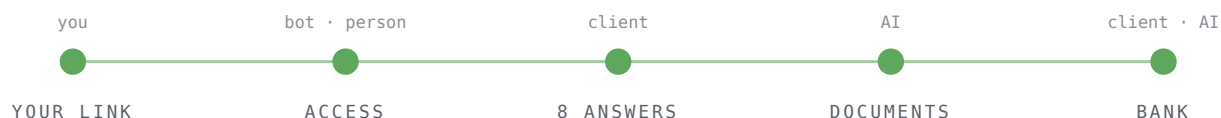
THE PLATFORMS' RULES

You're a person there, not a bot. Real replies under real posts, a rhythm a human keeps, the link when asked. No bulk messages, no scripts, no flooding — that gets an account banned and helps nobody.

Everything else — where, how much, in what words, with what audience — is yours. Money moves only through the bot: the person pays for access themselves, you never touch it. That protects you as much as them.

Two lines. Inside them — no limits.

After the link — the person's road



Through your link the bot shows what it is, the price and the doors — and the partner line. Access opens (Stars at once, other ways after a person confirms). Eight answers in one message. Documents in one message. Replies from the platform or the bank go back to the bot; it prepares the next letter. "Money came back" closes the case. You take part in none of it — your work is done the moment they tap "start", and your half is counted the moment access opens.

Today — first steps

YOU	KRIS
1. Watch the film on the site. All of it, once. Now you know what they'll hear.	Answers any question the same day.
2. Walk through the bot up to the payment button — see it with their eyes.	Confirms non-Stars payments within the day.
3. /refer → three lines → "I agree" → your link, this guide, your cabinet.	Pays weekly, by the cabinet.
4. Pick two places from the map — any two. Three conversations today.	Picks the contest winner, sends the code.
5. One person who told you such a story — the film and "Want me to show you?"	Holds everything else: the bot, the documents, the bank, the care.

The first payment through your link isn't a sale. It's a person who got a door because you said the truth first.

When they ask

THEY ASK	YOU ANSWER
How much?	\$195, once. Nothing from what comes back.
And if nothing comes back?	If nothing comes back in two weeks, the money comes back to you. — as written.
Are these lawyers?	No. Not a legal service. The AI builds the documents, the bank decides.
How much has been returned?	\$1,370.87 so far — every number with a screenshot, the counter is on the site.
Who's behind it?	The startup CLAIM, founder Kris — @kris_claim, channel @claim_project.
What do you get?	Half. Openly.
Anything else	@claim_project_support — a real person, in writing, the same day.

Why it works

The startup CLAIM connected two sides: a person who needs the product, and a product that already works. Between them — you. Not a seller. The one who said the truth first and gets half for it.

Everything in this guide exists today. Open the bot, take your link, reply to three people — and watch the first payment appear in your cabinet. Then do it with pleasure, at your own pace, without a ceiling.
